



## Table Games

### NON COMMISSION BACCARAT

**Player:** All winning player and banker bets.

**Banker:** are paid even money. Pays 1 to 1.

Except in the case of the bank winning with a total of 6, then winning bets are paid half.

Pays 1 to 2.

Bets on the tie win when the Player and Banker totals are the same. Pays 8 to 1.

### COMMISSION BACCARAT

**Player:** Winning bets on Player are paid even money. Pays 1 to 1

**Banker:** Winning bets on Banker are paid 19 to 20. We say this as even money less 5% 'commission'. Pays 19 to 20.

**Ties:** Bets on the tie win when the Player and Banker totals are the same. Pays 8 to 1.

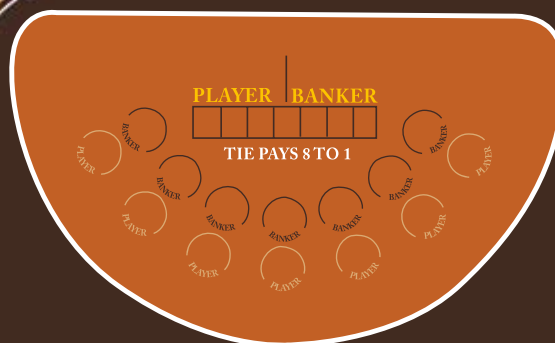

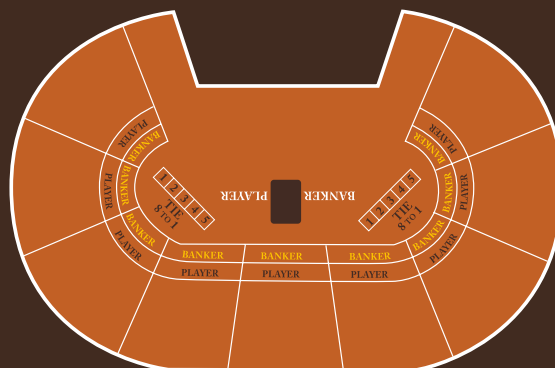

# How to Play

Baccarat is an old game, indeed, one of the oldest in the Casinos. There are many sources pertaining to it, but its true roots are indeed lost in the shadows. The Italian word “baccarat” means “zero” in English.

Since the French “baccarat” means the same, even today there are many debates pertaining to the origin of the game and each country wants to claim it as theirs.

Baccarat is a popular casino game and you will see various styles of dealing, payout and tables throughout SKYCITY Darwin.

In Baccarat the best total is 9. Tens and picture cards count as zero, and all the other cards count as their face value e.g Aces are worth 1. Please note that any total over 10, only the last digit counts. e.g  $9 + 6 = 15$ , which in Baccarat is 5.

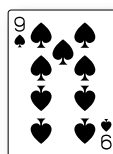
You can bet on the Player or the Banker to win, and/or tie.

The Dealer will draw the cards according to the Tableau (see table at right) to determine a winner.

When the Dealer has paid the winning bets you may place a new bet for the next hand.

## The Tableau

### PLAYERS HAND

| Total of first two cards | Outcome            |
|--------------------------|--------------------|
| 1,2,3,4,5                | Draws a third card |
| 6,7                      | Stand              |
| *8,*9                    | 'Natural' - Stands |

### BANKER WINS

When the first two cards total zero, one or two, the Banker's Hand draws the card. When the total of the Banker's first two cards is three or more, the outcome depends on the third card drawn by the Player, as shown in the table below.

| Total of first two cards   | Draws a card when Player's third card is | Stands when Player's third card is |
|----------------------------|--|------------------------------------|
| 3                          | 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10                     | 8                                  |
| 4                          | 2,3,4,5,6,7                              | 1,8,9,10                           |
| 5                          | 4,5,6,7                                  | 1,2,3,8,9,10                       |
| 6                          | 6,7                                      | 1,2,3,4,5,8,9,10                   |
| 7 - Stands                 |  |                                    |
| *8,*9 - 'Natural' - Stands |  |                                    |

On a 'Natural' no further cards will be drawn to either hand.
