HOW TO PLAY



How to Play

Caribbean Stud Poker is played with one deck of playing cards. The object of the game is to get a better hand of 5 cards than the dealer. The hands in Caribbean Stud Poker are the same as in draw poker. The ranking of the hands are shown on the next page. Caribbean Stud Poker has the added excitement of a progressive jackpot. For \$1 you have the chance to win jackpots. The jackpots vary depending on the hand you get.

Bets and Odds



ROYAL FLUSH

The highest hand in Caribbean Stud Poker - the top five cards of the same suit (10, Jack, Queen, King, Ace).

Pays 250 to 1. Maximum Payout 100% of jackpot or \$25,000 (whichever is larger).



STRAIGHT FLUSH

Five consecutive cards of the same suit, other than a Royal Flush (the Ace is counted as high or low).

Pays 50 to 1. 10% of jackpot or \$2,500 (whichever is larger).



FOUR OF A KIND

Any four cards of the same face value, plus any other odd card.

Pays 20 to 1

\$500



FULL HOUSE

Any three cards of the same face value plus any other two cards of the same face value.

Pays 7 to 1

\$150



FLUSH

Any five cards of the same suit, but not running consecutively.

Pays 5 to 1

\$100



STRAIGHT

Five consecutive cards of more than one suit. Pays 4 to 1



THREE OF A KIND

Any three cards of the same face value plus any other two odd cards. Pays 3 to 1



TWO PAIRS

Any two cards of the same face value, plus another two cards of the same face value (but different for the first pair) plus any other odd card. Pays 2 to 1



ONE PAIR

Any two cards of the same face value, plus any other three odd cards. Pays 1 to 1



ACE/KING

An ace and a King (any or mixed suit), plus any other three odd cards. All winning Antes are paid even money. Pays 1 to 1.
