

A. STRAIGHT UP pays 35 to 1
A bet on a single number.

B. SPLIT pays 17 to 1 This bet covers two numbers.

C. STREET pays 11 to 1 This bet covers three numbers.

D. CORNER pays 8 to 1 This bet covers four numbers.

E. SIX LINE pays 5 to 1 This bet covers six numbers.

F. COLUMNS pays 2 to 1 These are the areas marked 2 to 1. This bet covers the twelve numbers in the column above the betting area.

G. DOZENS pays 2 to 1 These are the areas marked 1st 12, 2nd 12, and 3rd 12. The bet covers the twelve numbers in the adjacent dozen.

H. EVEN CHANCES pays 1 to 1 This bet covers all red/black, even/odd, or low/high numbers.



Roulette is one of the most popular and exciting games to play in the casino.

Roulette is a casino and gambling game named after the French word meaning "small wheel".

In the game a croupier spins a wheel in one direction, then spins a ball in the opposite direction around a tilted circular surface running around the circumference of the wheel.

The ball eventually falls on to the wheel and into one of 37 colored and numbered pockets on the wheel.

How it Works

The main pockets are numbered from 1 to 36 alternating between red and black, but the pockets are not in numerical order around the wheel, and there are instances of consecutive numbers being the same color.

There is a green pocket numbered 0. Players can place a variety of 'inside' bets (selecting the number of the pocket the ball will land in, or range of pockets based on their position) and 'outside' bets (including bets on various positional

groupings of pockets, pocket colors, or whether it is odd or even).

The payout odds for each type of bet is based on its probability. The Roulette table has many different betting options and you can play as many or as few as you like.

There are usually posted rules for table minimum and maximum bets, and these rules usually apply separately for all of a players 'inside' and 'outside' bets for each spin.

Players can continue to place bets until the dealer announces "No more bets."
